Victor Frankl, a Holocaust survivor, said, *“Everything can be taken from man but one thing: the last of human freedoms – to choose one’s attitude in any given set of circumstances; to choose one’s way.”*

You have a **new year** before you. Which way do **YOU** choose?

1. **The path of happiness** – by trusting in Christ Jesus and surrendering everything to Him. By abiding in Him. By waiting upon God. By soaring above the storms through the power of The Holy Spirit.
2. **The path of the world’s captivity** – by being tethered by ropes of discouragement, disappointment, wrongdoing, doubt, fear, and joyless existence.

YOU HAVE THE CHOICE. Why not choose to **fly**?

1. **Fly** by **using your wings**. Until you use your wings, you won’t get off the ground. You **MUST start somewhere!** Stop tunneling through obstacles – soar above them by the power of The Holy Spirit.

3. **Fly** by **refusing to seek help and answers from the world**. In Isaiah 30:16, the Israelites were told to not “**flee upon horses**”. Why not? Because **the enemies’ horses will be faster and overtake you EVERY TIME!!!**

When playing ball games, the players have 2 choices: 1. **Defense** – keep the other team from scoring; 2. **SCORE!!!** Let your choice be **SCORE! SCORE BY FLYING!!! Choose** to keep a positive attitude. **Choose** to respond positively when the enemy uses someone against you. **Choose** to treat everyone else with love and respect. **Choose** to stay close to God and **allow His Spirit to live in you and work through you!**
